<mark>alumnus /əˈlʌm.nəs/</mark> noun

pl. alumni /əˈlʌm.naɪ/

someone who has left a school, college, or university after finishing their studies there, a graduate

alumna(noun) /əˈlʌmnə/ noun

pl. alumnae /əˈlʌmniː/

a female graduate

fail, verb

to not succeed in what you are trying to achieve or are expected to do

Examples:

- 1. This method of growing tomatoes never fails.
- 2. He failed in his attempt to break the record.
- 3. Mr. Kawahara says you're failing.
- 4. She failed to reach the Wimbledon Final this year.

afford: verb

to be able to buy or do something because you have enough money or time

Examples:

- 1. I can't afford to buy a house.
- 2. I can't afford this place without scholarship.
- 3. I don't know how he can afford a new car on his salary.
- 4. I'd have been happy to work there without pay if I could have afforded it.

buckle down: verb

to start working hard

Examples:

- 1. He'll have to buckle down soon if he wants to pass his finals.
- 2. Now it's time to buckle down.

ace: verb

to do very well in an exam

Examples:

- 1. Kawahara says that you'll be fine if you ace the midterm.
- 2. I was up all night studying, but it was worth it I aced my chemistry final.

eat, sleep, and breathe something, idiom

to be extremely interested in something because it is very important to you

Examples:

- 1. I don't care what the cost is; it's my passion. I eat, breathe, and sleep this car.
- 2. One of the reasons he's been so successful is that he eats, drinks, and sleeps baseball.
- 3. She eats and breathes music.
- 4. It is hard to fault a guy who lives, eats, and breathes the job he has been given.
- 5. I promise I will eat, sleep, and breathe biology.
